CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS SCHEDULE

SECTION 15.1.2

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows (*includes the dog awarded Winners):

Dogs competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated:	0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level.

SECTION 15.1.8

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided a dog was defeated at the group level.

Section 15.1.12

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three different judges and.
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC *Event Registration Number*.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
