

Mrs. Robert D. (Polly) Smith, of St. Stephens Church, Virginia, began showing dogs as a child for her neighbor, who owned and showed Chow Chows. Later, she showed horses and took her mare with her when she went to Mary Washington College in Fredericksburg, Virginia.

After marriage, Mrs. Smith returned to showing dogs in 1962 with a German Shepherd that did much better in obedience than conformation. It is at this point that she bought her husband an American Foxhound, which he showed to numerous Bests in Show. They then began to develop the Hazira line of American Foxhounds and produced three generations of Best in Show- and six generations of group-winning American Foxhounds.

Mrs. Smith began her judging career in 1978 and became an allbreed judge in 2007. She has judged on five continents and has filled several previous AKC/Eukanuba National Championship assignments, including the Working Group (2005) and Best in Show (2011, Standard Poodle GCh. Jaset's Satisfaction).

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed here under.

A class Dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN).
