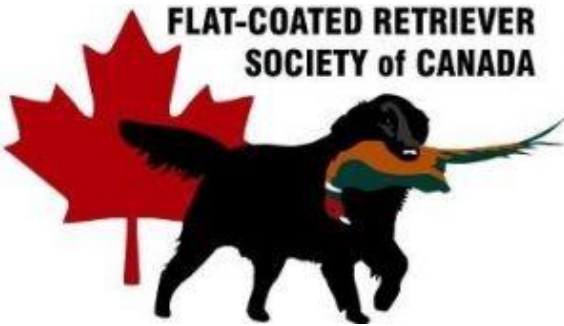

General Information:

- Bitches in season will not be eligible to compete and are not allowed on the test grounds. Fees refunded with a veterinary certificate confirming the bitch is in heat.
- Ducks, pheasants, and/or chukars may be used.
- A rosette and a prize will be awarded to all qualifiers.
- No training is allowed on the testing ground.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Working Certificate Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- By attending this test, competitors and spectators acknowledge that the Flat-Coated Retriever Society of Canada, test officials and landowners involved do not accept liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred by exhibitors, dogs or spectators.

## Swallowfield Estuary

**Directions to Headquarters:** Swallowfield Road is North of Duncan and South of Chemainus. Turn East off of the #1 Trans-Canada Highway onto Mt. Sicker Road. Follow Mt. Sicker Road to the T-junction, and then turn Left onto Chemainus Road. When you reach Crofton Road stay left, and after about 100m turn right onto Swallowfield Road (look for the PRHRC sign). Drive through the gate, proceed until you reach the T-junction, and then turn right to proceed to the Headquarters, which will be located at the Hydroxyl field area. **PRHRC** signs will help guide the way.

Please note there will no concessions on the grounds. The nearest stores are in Chemainus, approximately 10-15 minutes' drive from the grounds.

If travelling by ferry from the Lower Mainland, **reservations on BC Ferries are recommended.** The nearest terminal is Duke Point if travelling from Tsawwassen. Go to [www.bcferrries.com](http://www.bcferrries.com).
