**2. ENTER ONLINE**



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or Interac for payment.

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The tendering of NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Exhibitors whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00 for each transaction declined. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted.

Attention foreign exhibitors, please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you sent a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please DO NOT make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

## **CLASSES, TITLES & AWARDS:**

Titles may be earned by class or by component. A dog may be entered in either the class or the component they are eligible for. Titles will be awarded once requirements are met for the class or component. For complete details:

**ENTRY LIMIT:** These Trials are limited. If the tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

Handlers may only handle 1 dog in each component at each level. Dogs can only be entered in Open through Masters if they have obtained a qualifying score in the preceding level component.

**MOVE UPS:** Same day trial move-ups will not be allowed. Move-ups for the Sunday trial are permitted if space allows. Please submit by the end of the first trial day.

**JUDGING SCHEDULES:** sent by email to exhibitors after the closing date

**EQUIPMENT:** The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness in the ring. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn in the ring. Harnesses may have the leash attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the grounds.

**PENALTIES ISSUED BY THE CLUB:** Dropping food while rewarding is considered contamination. Contamination of the search area, at the discretion of the Judge may result in a non-qualifying score. Any dog that urinates or defecates or vomits within the search area will be excused from the class and will result in a non-qualifying score.

**SCENT DETECTION RULEBOOK:** It is up to the individual handler to review the CKC Scent Detection Rulebook prior to the trial. New rulebook Jan 1, 2024.

**REMINDER:** That anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.

**BITCHES IN SEASON:** Bitches in season are permitted to compete at this event. They must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties.

**ADDITIONAL TRIAL AND VENUE INFORMATION:**

1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the trial. The Event Chairperson shall have full control of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the chairperson or veterinarian for any reason, shall not, after being excused compete in any class for any award for the balance of the trial.
3. The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability for, either dogs, exhibitors or patrons in the event of an accident or misfortune.
4. The owner of a dog entered in these trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
5. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, there is no refund of entry.
6. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a scent detection trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
7. Schedules are based on 2 minutes per dog for Instinct, 9 minutes per dog for Novice and Open, 14 minutes per dog for Excellent, and 17 minutes per dog for Masters (all components).
8. Please allow for absentees and variances in the rate of judging.
9. Please Obey ENTER and EXIT gates in the trial area.
10. Dogs and equipment shall not be left unattended at the trial venue.
11. Dogs must be on leash at all times inside the trial venue and trial grounds.

12. Exhibitors will be required to crate their dogs in their vehicle. Please be prepared for all types of weather.

13. Spectators are permitted but only in designated areas. Food other than that used as a distraction for the search will not be allowed. As per CKC Rules Spectators are encouraged to photo and video dogs and handlers while they search, however under no circumstances may they share this with any handler competing in the same class who has not yet run. Handlers are not allowed to take video while handling a dog. These videos are for the enjoyment of those who cannot be present to watch the team search, and for the handler to have a keepsake of their experience.

14. Access to parking will be allowed starting at 8:00 am. Please Park neatly. Please adhere to Fire Lanes in all areas around the venue.

15. Master teams will need to climb stairs.

16. Exhibitors are expected to maintain a clean area. Please be considerate when utilizing any facilities. No dogs are permitted in the washrooms.

17. Bring your own food and drinks, for yourself and your dog.

18. No overnight recreational parking will be provided.

19. Exhibitors and Participants are expected to follow these event guidelines. Failure to comply may result in excusal from the remainder of this event. The club reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the show and the venue, which are governed by CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB (CKC) rules.

#### **VENUE INFO:**

No concession onsite.

Trials will be run rain or shine. Dress accordingly.

All dogs must be on leash except during the trial.

Please clean up after yourself and your dog.

There will be no dog to dog greetings or interactions.

There will be a dedicated reactive dog area please let the parking lot attendant know if this is where you want to be parked.

### **Payment and acceptance of entries shall indicate acceptance of such.**



I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold Shetland Sheepdog Club of BC, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
